

Dr. Robert Brodnick is the founder of Titan Analytical, and PhenoTerps Flavor House. Robert was previously appointed Chief Scientific Officer and head of quality at Food Safety Net Services, a nation-wide network of ISO 17025 accredited food and agricultural testing facilities. Prior to his leadership in the food and cannabis safety sectors, Robert served on active duty as a commissioned officer in the ranks of the US Army Medical Services Corps. Then, Major Brodnick contributed significantly to the medical chemical defense research program missions, he carried out numerous combat casualty care clinical investigations, and completed a tour of duty in Afghanistan in support on Operations Enduring Freedom. Major Brodnick spent the latter half of uniformed service leading and auditing counter narcotics laboratories under the DoD Drug Demand Reduction Program, where he supported over 100 cases as a court-qualified expert witness in quality assurance, laboratory testing, human performance and behavior, and service member drugs of abuse including opioids, alcohol, and cannabis. Having necessarily developed an informed appreciation for the safety and therapeutic potential of cannabis for those suffering from a myriad of ailments, particularly our Veterans experiencing PTSD and pain, Robert's career path is defined by a new mission: improving the quality and safety of products in the maturing cannabis and hemp supply chains. Dr. Brodnick received his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in analytical and biological chemistry from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and is a FSMA-complaint Preventive Controls Qualified Individual.
